In the books mentioned above the author has made a thorough study of the last will and testament of Dr. Alfred Bernhard Nobel and the statutes made by the Nobel Foundation, based on which the so-called “*Nobel Prizes*” are awarded. The said study has revealed the following startling facts:

- a. The prize, which was awarded to Prof. Amartya Sen in the year 1998, is neither a “*Nobel Prize*” nor he is a “*Nobel Laureate*”. This has been plainly admitted by the Nobel Foundation itself by e-mails to the author.
- b. Furthermore the prizes, which are being awarded since 1901 under the name “*Nobel Prizes*” cannot be named ***Nobel Prizes*** since these are awarded by the Nobel Foundation by violating the terms and conditions stipulated in the last will and testament of Dr. Alfred Bernhard Nobel.

- xii. **FERA is Dead Long Live FERA**

Critically analyzing the provisions contained in the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act 1947, the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act 1973 and the Foreign Exchange Management Act 1999, the author has concluded that no provision of FERA 1973 can be applied after 31st day of May, 2000 since FEMA 1999 did not repeal FERA 1973 but it caused its complete collapse. As a collapsed Act is unenforceable thus all the 12652 (twelve thousand six hundred and fifty two) cases of alleged contravention of FERA 1973, which were purportedly adjudicated and the alleged contraveners were imposed penalties to the tune of thousands of crore of rupees after FEMA came into force, are all void *ab initio*.
